Our Northern New Jersey chapter surprised Christine with a very special wish - a new laptop so she can communicate with her family in St. Vincent! Christine fell several years ago, breaking her hip and tibia. At the time, she was living in St. Vincent with her husband, a native, and their children. Because of her religious beliefs, she cannot accept a blood transfusion so there was no doctor on the island who would do a surgical repair of her hip. Thanks to a GoFundMe, Christine was able to travel to New Jersey where a surgeon was able to perform the surgery without a transfusion. She had planned to return to St. Vincent after the surgery, but had several complications which left her wheelchair bound. Christine keeps in touch with her family via zoom, but her old laptop was unreliable. Now, she can visit with her family as often as she wants!
